In the contents of the abstract, it is important to identify how your work is different from the previous works of yours and other groups. Following the background and the state of the art, introduce the basic ideas and present details of your new methodology. Then, clearly outline the specific results. Novelty claim should be supported by appropriate experimental or theoretical results. These results can be supported by figures and/or tables. Finally, compare your results with related works, and comment on the broader impact of the results.

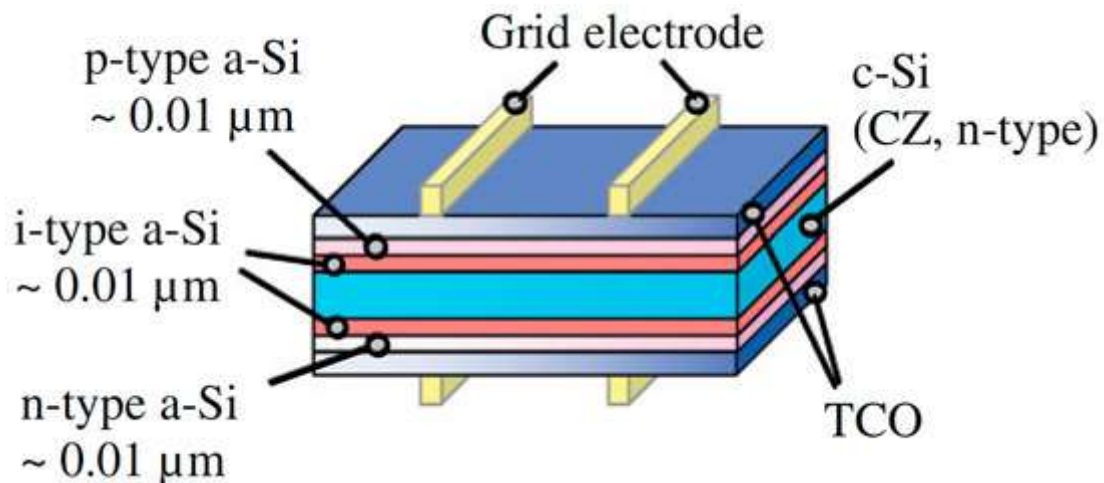


Fig. 1. STRUCTURE OF THE CELL

Regarding the table and figure, please use the suggested table and figure layouts to ensure a high degree of consistency in printing the publication. Digital images, e.g., schematic drawings, photos, micrographs, etc., should have a resolution of at least 600 dpi. Each figure should be accompanied by a numbered caption, as shown in Fig. 1. Do not use very thin lines (hairline rule) in any of your Illustrations, Figures, Charts and Tables.
